Parents' Charter

Kettering Tang Soo Do recognises that the happy and successful practice of our martial art is the result of a commitment between both the student and instructor. In the case of our junior members, we recognise that to achieve this aim a positive commitment from the parent/guardian is also needed and happily enters into this commitment: to help us produce happy, successful and confident students. We ask that parents help support their child/children and the instructor by following the guidelines below.

Safety

- 1) Bring your child to class on time
- 2) If you are unable to pick up your child yourself please inform the class instructor and give him the name of the person who will be picking your child up
- 3) If you are delayed for any reason and are going to be late picking your child up please contact the class instructor
- 4) Make sure that the class instructor has an up to date contact phone number. If you change your phone number please remember to give your new number to the instructor
- 5) If you have any concerns re your children please talk to the class instructor or the club's senior instructor

Training

- 1) Encourage your child to practice outside of class
- 2) Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance, behaviour and actions
- 3) Support your child's involvement in Tang Soo Do and help them enjoy their art. Try not to criticise their performance
- 4) Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performance of all. Do not compare your child's performance and skills with others
- 5) When in the training hall set a good example and use correct and proper language at all times
- 6) When in the training hall set an example and follow the rules of the Do Jhang as laid out in the grading record booklet.

Whilst we encourage parents to watch their children training, we request that the silence of the Do Jhang is maintained. We welcome any questions or comments either before or after training
